

Privacy Statement

Connacht Taekwon- Do Academy fully respects your rights to privacy and are committed to strict adherence to General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) which becomes fully effective on 25th May 2018 as well as the provisions of the Data Protection Act 2018.

This Privacy Statement sets out how Connacht Taekwon- Do Academy collects and processes any information that you give to us. We respect your privacy and are committed to protecting your personal data. This Privacy Statement explains how we collect, process, use and disclose your personal information and sets out our security practices.

(Please note that the terms "You/Your" may refer, interchangeably, to the member, or a Parent, in the case of a member being a child.

What we collect

We collect, only, personal information that you provide to us, which is information that identifies you as an individual. We only do this when you have provided us with the information, and you have given your consent that we can use it in your interest for the purposes set out in this Privacy Statement. This data may include your name, address, email address, phone number and relevant health information for the member.

In the case of Direct Debit payment method, you will be asked to provide banking details via a Direct Debit Mandate Form.

How we use your Personal Information and the Legal basis for doing so

Any personal information you provide, will be used for the purpose for which you supply it and will be treated with the highest standards of security and confidentiality, strictly in accordance with General Data Protection Regulations.

Your contact information will only be used for Taekwon-Do updates, and will not be passed on to any unrelated third party. Direct Debit Mandates will be forwarded, securely, via encryption, to our chosen billing utility – Educational Funding Company (EFC UK). Their Privacy Policy can be viewed <u>here</u>

By providing your personal information, we may use this to:

- Send individual/group texts with class updates, fee notifications, or event notifications.
- Send emails with event notifications, and other relevant Taekwon-Do updates.

The legal basis for processing your personal information is that you have explicitly given your consent to us.

This consent is typically given by completing an official Connacht Taekwon-Do application form. EFC Direct Debit Mandate, and/or booking a class through the Classes4Kids booking portal.

How long we keep your data

This will vary. We will retain the data for the duration of your membership of the Academy. Membership must be terminated, in writing, as specified in the Terms and Conditions on the application form.

Once membership is ended:

- the application form will be securely shredded within 6 months of the membershiptermination date
- your mobile number will be deleted from our student list
- your email address will remain on our mailing list, until such time as you either request removal, or unsubscribe yourself. The option to unsubscribe from the mailing list is contained with EVERY email we send out.

What are your rights?

- Right of access you have the right to request a copy of the application form, you submitted, in accordance with Section 86 of the Data Protection Act 2018
- Right of rectification you have a right to amend information on your application form that is inaccurate or incomplete, in accordance with Section 87 and Section 89 of the Data Protection Act 2018, e.g. if you move house or change your phone number. Please note, this is advisable, anyway, so you don't miss out on important notifications.
- Right to erasure in certain circumstances, you can ask for the data we hold about you to be erased from our records, in accordance with Section 87 and Section 89 of the Data Protection Act 2018
- Right to restriction of processing where certain conditions apply, to have a right to restrict the processing in accordance with Section 87 and Section 89 of the Data Protection Act 2018
- Right of portability subject to certain restrictions, you have the right to have the data we hold about you transferred to another organisation where we hold it in electronic form. This right of data portability applies to: (i) personal data that we process automatically (i.e. without any human intervention); (ii) personal data provided by you; and (iii) personal data that we process based on your consent or in order to fulfil a contract.
- Right to object you have the right to object to certain types of information processing such as direct marketing.

Cookies & Websites

Cookies allow websites and mobile applications to respond to you as an individual.
